## **Information for Applicants**

### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Wi Pere Trust education scholarships is to assist Wi Pere whānau to attend a tertiary institution to gain qualifications relevant to the Trust. The longer term aim is to recruit more whānau with tertiary qualifications which will aid them to attain senior positions in the Trust or similar businesses.

### **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

There are two new scholarships available each year for full time study, up to a maximum of six operating at one time.

The scholarships are open to any member of the whānau.

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

Each scholarship is worth \$4,500 per year and is payable in three instalments, subject to enrolment in the tertiary institution. Instalment payments are as follows:

\$1,500 on evidence of enrolment

\$1,500 subject to semester 1 academic results being approved by Trust Board

\$1,500 subject to semester 2 academic results being approved by Trust Board

Scholarship holders will be expected to keep the Trust informed of any difficulties they may experience during the academic year. They will also need to provide a summary of their academic results throughout the year.

The Trust reserves the right to terminate the scholarship on the basis of unsatisfactory conduct or progress on the part of the scholar.

Each scholarship may be renewable for the following year if the current scholarship holder has attained academic grades equivalent to a "B+" average.

Scholarship holders will be encouraged to undertake paid vacation work at the Trust, if it is available.

The Trust will endeavour to provide permanent employment on the completion of the tertiary qualification, if it is available.

### **CRITERIA FOR SELECTION**

Consideration will be given to applicants studying in New Zealand any undergraduate degree relevant to the Wi Pere Trust. Preference will be given to agricultural, horticultural, forestry or business students.

Applicants should have:-

- a a good academic record
- b personal attributes suitable for work in the Trust
- c the capacity to carry out the full range of technical duties as required by the Trust
- d community and cultural associations and identity
- e an interest in a career with the Trust or similar businesses
- f a willingness to work for the Trust during the long vacation and/or completion of full time study, if available.

2 Applicants must ensure that they have pre-enrolled at tertiary institutions which require this.

3 Applicants must have included:-

- a Copies of academic records/results
- b Their names, addresses and contact numbers of at least three referees who can comment on your personal qualities, skills and experience in the following areas:-
  - ⇒ academic areas
  - ⇒ paid or unpaid work
  - ⇒ community involvement

Suitable referees could include:-

- ⇒ School Principal or Senior Teacher
- ⇒ Current or recent Lecturer
- ⇒ Teacher or Tutor in other training areas
- ⇒ Iwi, hapu or community group
- ⇒ Employer or supervisor in a position of responsibility who has been involved in a work situation (includes unpaid, voluntary, part or full time)

***NB: Referees should be independent of family members***

## SELECTION PROCESS

Applicants will be informed in February if they have been chosen by the Selection Panel to be interviewed so those applying will need to be able to attend interviews in February or March should these be necessary.

Applicants may bring whanau support/support people to the interview, however, the Trust will only meet applicants travel costs.

The Trust reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship should there not be suitable applicants.

The Scholarship must be formally accepted within two weeks of being offered, and it must be taken up in the year offered.
